

Biblical Confessions to Build Your Faith

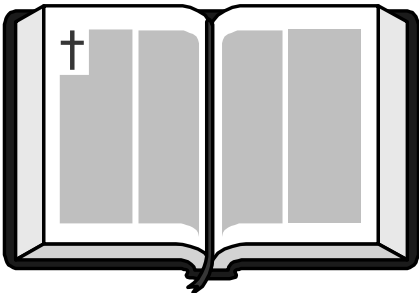

Who We Are in Christ

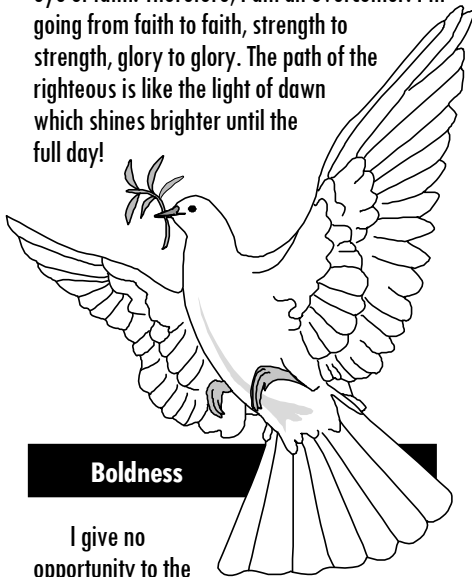
